Awards: Medals will be awarded to all first-place finishers

- 1. <u>ALL HANDS MEETING</u> to be held at 9:30 a.m. in picnic pavilion on the lake shore. Coaches will be given bow numbers for their team at this meeting. You will not be timed if you cross either the start or finish line without a visible entry number.
- FLIGHTS Races start at 11 a.m. There will be four flights, with competitors starting approximately every 30 seconds to allow for each flight to finish before the next begins. NOTE: Race schedule may be compressed to avoid long delays. However, intervals between flights will remain unchanged.
   Please check the final schedule race day for race times.
- 3. **HANDICAPPING** Masters crews' average ages are REQUIRED on the entry form for time handicapping. Masters entries without a specified age will be calculated as age 27. Handicap is 8 seconds per year.
- 4. **EQUIPMENT** All shells must have bow balls and heel ties.
- 5. <u>TEAM POINTS AWARD</u> will be based upon boats entered in the Masters category Women 4X, Men 4X, Mixed 8+ and Mixed 2X events\*\*TP\*\*. Points will be given for the 1<sup>st</sup> boat <u>from each crew/team</u> that crosses the finish line; 3 points for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2 points for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 1 points for 3 <sup>rd</sup>. If a team has multiple boats in the same event only the 1<sup>st</sup> boat from their team that crosses the line will earn points towards the Team Points Award.
  - \*\*BONUS POINTS will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place entries in the Lip Sync Battle to be held during the post regatta BBQ (entries are open to individual and/or groups and Novice, Junior and Master crew rowers, costumes are encouraged but not required).
- 6. <u>SNACKS, DRINKS & BBQ</u> The pavilion will have snacks, coffee, hot water, and Gatorade during the flights. A BBQ, awards ceremony and Lip Sync Battle will follow the final flight. Camping Saturday evening is highly encouraged!
